NUTRITION

Feeding your cat a high quality diet which contains optimal levels of vitamins and minerals will have many health benefits.

Cats are **obligate carnivores** and must have meat or fish in their diet to obtain essential nutrients. Homemade vegetarian diets are contra-indicated for cats and will cause serious health problems. For example, the amino acid *taurine* is only found in proteins of animal origin and deficiency in cats causes blindness and heart disease.

It is preferable to feed a commercial diet which has been rigorously tested for nutritional content and will contain optimum levels of vitamins and minerals. Giving the occasional treat of coley or chicken breast is absolutely fine. Frequent feeding of liver should be avoided as this causes excessive vitamin A absorption which can lead to vertebrae in the spine fusing together.

Your cat's nutritional requirements will vary according to life stage;

kitten (up to 1 year old)

adult (1-7 years) or

senior (over 7 years old)...

Kittens need more protein and have higher energy requirements than adults so kitten foods are higher in fat.

Adult cats' requirements will vary according to their lifestyle. Sedentary cats are more likely to become obese. Certain cat foods, particularly the highly palatable premium brands, can be higher in fat.

Dental disease often develops in adult cats fed certain diets, as the food adheres to the tooth enamel and leads to the formation of plaque and then tartar. Gum disease can allow bacteria to enter the bloodstream and could impact on your cat's health. In most cats it is extremely difficult to attempt tooth-brushing so it is preferable to feed a diet that reduces plaque formation in the first place.

Senior cats benefit from controlled levels of sodium and phosphorus to protect their kidneys.
